Sir,

I am pleased to inform you that you have qualified the UGC-NET for Junior Research Fellowship (JRF) held on 28th JUNE 2009.

You are now eligible for being considered by Universities / Institutions for the award of JRF. The validity period of the offer is two years from the date of issue of this letter. The commencement of fellowship will depend on your joining M.Phil./Ph.D. programme. In case you have joined M.Phil./Ph.D. programme prior to the declaration of NET result, you will be eligible to get the fellowship from the date of declaration of NET result, i.e., 14th December 2009.

It may please be noted that the award of JRF will be made by the Universities/Institutions in accordance with the procedure already communicated to them and not by UGC. You are, therefore, advised to contact the University / Institution in which you have already registered/wish to do M.Phil. or Ph.D. for the award of Junior Research Fellowship.

The concerned institution should verify the orginal certificates of the candidate. Wherever PH or VH appears in the UGC - Ref. No., the relevant documents of Physical or Visual disability should be checked. It should also be verified whether the candidate fulfils the minimum eligibility conditions for Junior Research Fellowship (JRF), i.e., at least 55% marks in Master's Degree (or) equivalent examination from a university/institution recognised by UGC for General/OBC and 50% for SC/ST/PH/VH candidates within two years from the date of declaration of UGC-NET result.

The candidate should not be more than 28 years of age as on the first day of the month of the concerned UGC-NET, relaxable by five years for SC/ST/OBC/PH/VH/Female candidates. Relaxation in age up to 3 years is provided to candidates who have done LLM and to research scholars for the period of research. Total relaxation on the above ground(s) cannot exceed five years.

The certificate for Lectureship eligibility is being issued separately.
